



Hazmat Placard Protectors

With minimal care, your new polycarbonate hazmat placard protectors will do their job year after year. Use the guidelines below to keep them in their best shape.



Cleaning:

- Clean after use and before storing, or as necessary.
- Wipe protector clean with a damp towel or cloth to remove abrasive particles and dirt.
- DO NOT wipe dry.
- DO NOT clean in the hot sun or at temperatures at or above 200°F.

To remove scratches:

- Use gentle, polycarbonate-friendly products such as:
 - Meguiar's Plastic Cleaner/Polish
 - Craftics 20/20 Plasti-Polish Scratch Remover
 - Brasso Polish/Cleaner
 - Plastic headlight polish
- DO NOT use products which are abrasive or highly alkaline (for example, ammonia contained in some glass cleaners).
- DO NOT use solvents (for example – acetone, carbon tetrachloride, benzene or leaded gasoline).

Storage:

- Clean before storing.
- Store vertically.

Remember:

Your protectors keep placards securely in place saving you hassle from dealing with the sticky back. And they protect placards from damage due to weather and road debris. Take care of your protectors and they will do their job keeping you from violations resulting in lost time and money.
